Parish Council received a few applications to fill in 1 Parish Councillor Vacancy A new member will be co-opted at July meeting

June meeting was well attended by members of the public, HDC and CCC Councillors, U&C and Savills representatives.

Many concerns raised by the residents regarding the road safety were answered by R Britton, Urban & Civic. It was noted at the time that the Audit has been carried out and report issued. This has not been worked through by officers for the County response to it. U&C have a technical design meeting on site with the County team to review the core points against their views and were then looking to get a meeting in the diary to sit down with parish and district councillors who want to be involved to go through. Key aspects of this discussion relate to looking at the works in the context of the next phase of works; additional speed limit measures already discussed; and additional works that might be needed to respond to the safety audit or parish council views.

Phase 2:

The second phase of works includes the cycle way, pedestrian crossings and gateway features. PC feedback is required.

Maintenance and condition:

U&C have been in discussion with the contractor about the nature of the verges and the timing is not great for many of the landscape management options along with the potential redoing of some of works for additional lighting, signage or junction works, which U&C cannot discount at the moment.

U&C have asked their landscape contractors to provide options which would enable the key areas to be tidied up in the short term and have a longer-term low maintenance but attractive look. U&C will come back on this.

Parish Council thanked R Britton for all advice and co-operation as well as attending the meetings.

Planning Committee had a very useful meeting. Committee is now re-invigorated and consists of Councillors S Smith, T Close, S Burton, A Hallihan and A Cull. Chairman is a member of every Committee and Working group. The last meeting was attended by T Slater, planning advisor.

Installation of low level air source heat pumps and associated timber protective louvred enclosures (Barn C Only) Site Address: Pringle Farm Pringle Way Little Stukeley Reference: 19/00824/LBC - *No PC comments*.

There were a few concerns raised regarding the maintenance of both villages / grasses cutting, and it was agreed to write to the contractor seeking clarification. The letter has been sent, awaiting the outcome.

Village litter pick was carried out by the Scouts. More than 10 bags of litter collected. Parish Council thanked the Scouts and their Leaders.

Parish Council with the help of Urban & Civic are considering gateway features for both villages.

The owner or occupier of a property has a legal responsibility (Highway Act 1980 s154) to ensure that the "public highway" adjacent to a property is not obstructed by vegetation from their property.

REFLECTIONS: KEW, the ROYAL BOTANICAL GARDENS Tuesday 21st May,2019

This was an amazing visit! My thirty-eight (38) strong group were in an excited mood due to the superb weather. It was WARM and SUNNY-just perfect weather for this visit with absolutely no rain in the forecast.

We departed from Great Stukeley Village Hall on time at 8.00am. On our arrival at *Kew* we were met at the *Elizabeth Gate* by our well informed host Eric White who kindly gave us some tips on things we should see and those to keep a lookout for. Included in the cover price was morning coffee and the Free Pass to use the hop-on/hop-off *Kew Explorer* road train with its seven stops around the entire Garden. Some of my group. At the time of our visit the *Chihuly Reflections on Nature* exhibition with iconic glass artwork in inspired settings was an added attraction. There was also the *Treetop Walkway*, the *Royal Kitchens*, the *Key Palace*, the *Palm House* and the *Princess of Wales 'Conservatory*-to name but a few of *Kew's* treasures.

The day was full to the brim with exciting discoveries and interesting exhibits, good company and enjoyable lunches and snacks at *Kew's* six restaurants.


