

**ROYAL AIR FORCE MUSEUM, Hendon**  
***Tuesday 21st April 2020***  
**FULL PAYMENT DUE**

The *Museum* site at *Hendon* is Britain's *Cradle of Aviation*. *Hendon* was one of the first civilian airfields in Britain and was acquired by the pioneer aviator Claude Graham-White, holder of Britain's 6th Pilot's Certificate. During the First World War the aerodrome was requisitioned and became a Royal Naval Air Service Station training pilots. Among whom were Albert Ball, Mick Mannock and Reginald Warneford-all awarded the Victoria Cross.

The Royal Air Force acquired *Hendon* in 1925 and from 1927 through 1939 housed 601 Squadron- known as the "*the Millionaires*" due to the wealth and social class of its volunteers. In 1939 *Hendon* became the home of 24 Transport & Communications Squadron and several Squadrons of fighters during the *Battle of Britain*. The RAF suspended operational flying in 1968 and closed the base in 1972.

Today *Hendon* is home of one of the largest and most famous Aviation Museums in the World with over 100 aircraft and many other fascinating displays and interactive exhibits and is a part of our national heritage.




