#### Dear Sir / Madam

We write to inform you that we will be carrying out essential maintenance on the A1(M) southbound between junction 14 and Alconbury Interchange and northbound between Brampton and junction 14. This work is to make sure that the road continues to be safe for motorists to use.

To minimise disruption to the travelling public we will carry out this work within existing closures that are taking place for the A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon Improvement scheme.

#### What are the benefits to road users?

Our work will provide a safer and smoother journey for road users and will also reduce road noise as we will be using a very low noise surface treatment. We are also making additional improvements to the safety barriers, and carrying out work on the bridge joints as well as gully cleaning and vegetation clearing. Doing this during the planned closure will reduce the need for future closures.

#### When is the work taking place?

30 August 2019 - 24 September 2019

#### Traffic restrictions – check before you travel

The A1(M) will be **closed to traffic** on the following dates to enable work to be carried out safely.

#### Full weekend road closures

A1(M) Southbound only - Between junction 14 to Alconbury Interchange

21:00 hours Friday 30 August to 06:00 hours Monday 2 September

21:00 hours Friday 6 September to 06:00 hours Monday 9 September

#### A1(M) Northbound only - Between Brampton to junction 14

21:00 hours Friday 6 September to 06:00 hours Monday 9 September

21:00 hours Friday 13 September to 06:00 hours Monday 16 September

21:00 hours Friday 20 September to 06:00 hours Monday 23 September

#### Lane 1 only closures

Lane 1 of this section will also be closed from Monday to Friday 05:00 hours until 21:00 hours on the following dates

A1(M) Southbound only - Between junction 14 to Alconbury Interchange
05:00 hours Monday 2 September until 21:00 hours Friday 6 September

A1(M) Northbound only - Between Brampton to junction 14

05:00 hours Monday 9 September until 21:00 hours Friday 20 September

During this time we will be making the lanes on the A1(M) narrower than usual and the speed limit will be reduced to 40mph.

Traffic will exit at junction 14 and continue to Spittals junction where it will join the A14 westbound until it merges back onto the A1(M) at Brampton Hut junction.

### A1(M) closure Northbound

Traffic will exit at Brampton Hut junction and join the A14 eastbound until Spittals junction where it will join the A14M northbound and merge back onto the A1(M) at junction 14
