

LAWN CARE IN EARLY SPRING

Mowing

If conditions allow get out the mower and lightly cut the lawn. Make sure mower has been serviced and blade replaced or sharpened.

Fertiliser

This is the time to feed and weed (preferably in that order).

The fertiliser is predominately Nitrogen in a slow release form, but it may also need Phosphate and Potassium as well as vital trace elements.

Moss

Moss may still be a problem so either apply lawn sand or apply a specific moss control product (liquid iron). It is best to do it now before the spring starts.

Actions required in Early Spring

- Mow lawn lightly when dry enough.
- Treat Moss
- Apply Spring Feed

Some of the above tasks can be carried out by the lawn owner, other tasks may need some professional intervention.
